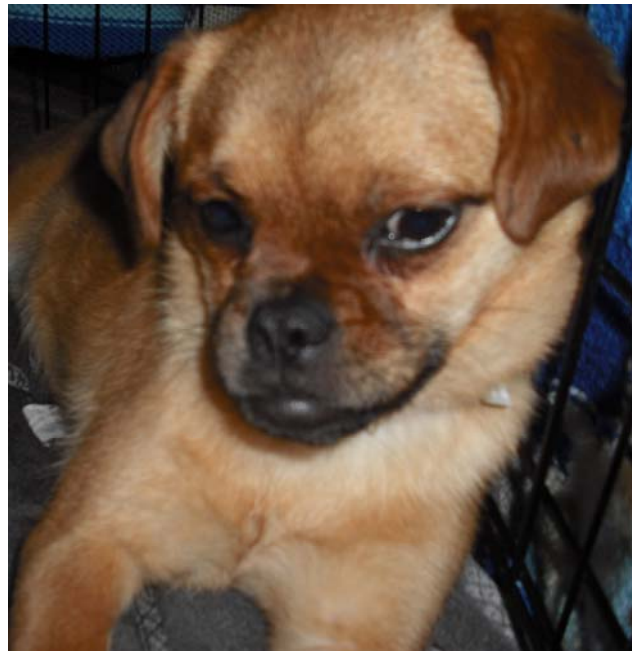
Pet of the Month
